Our focus: diversity in nature and in society

The mission of Diversity Foundation is to build an inclusive society that is ecologically responsible and sustainable.

Organization: public utility NGO Activities with current team since 2017, social farm since 2019 Staff:

• 4 full time + 3 part-time (20 hrs/week) + 3 part-time (1 day/week) + 15-20 volunteers

Activities:

- Ecological gardening
- Labour market reintegration programs
- International projects vocational education program development
- Social integration programs
- Awareness raising programs





Our social farm: SZIA Agroecology Garden

- Location: Gödöllő, territory of MATE University
- Cooperation agreement with MATE hosting the international student community
- 2500 m2 area ecological gardening no organic certification
- Vegetables, herbs, pollinator flowers
- No-till gardening, composting, mulching
- Head gardener + 3 gardeners with disabilities (employment of disadvantaged people)
- Polytunnel, irrigation system, raised beds, cold storage room







SZIA Agroecology Garden – social enterprise

- Goal: economic self-sufficiency
- Market garden, selling produce to:
 - Restaurant in Budapest
 - Local food community
- Up-cycle handcraft products
 - Seed bomb bonbons and flowering paper with recycled paper
 - Ornaments from used coffee capsules
 - Activity in winter and on rainy days for gardeners with disability
- Services to partner companies
 - Offering company family day programs making seed bombs, bath salt with herbs







SZIA Agroecology Garden – education & community

- International students community gardening, community events
- University interns, volunteers
- Student groups, university lectures and practical lessons
- Community composting facility
- Family days with informal & practical education programs
- Team building programs for partner companies
- Workshops for backyard and small scale gardeners

Social farm training for social and agricultural professionals

- 48 hours/6 days
- Methodology of Practical Skills Therapeutic Education (PSTE Ruskin Mill, UK)
- Training module on economical sustainability


Project results:
